10 STEPS TO SAFER PLAYING TOGETHER

- ✓ Please do not use the play areas or Skate Park if you or any members of your household are displaying Covid19 symptoms
- ✓ Consumption of food & drink is banned in play areas/Skate Park
- ✓ Where possible, please provide your own hand sanitiser / wipes to clean hands before and after use of play equipment
- ✓ Remind your child(ren) not to touch their face, put fingers in their mouths
- ✓ In busy periods, 20 minutes max play - please be considerate to other children waiting
- ✓ Please use the chalked markers on the path as a guidance for queuing during busy periods
- ✓ Always adhere to the 2m rule for social distancing – a play park is a high risk area for transmission of Covid19
- ✓ Advisory Limit – *please adhere to this in each area*
 - max of 3 households in Main St play area
 - max of 4 households in Sandwath play area
 - max of 3 people on the wooden play equipment (Main St)
 - max of 3 people on the Skate Park
- ✓ Children must be accompanied by an adult from their household
- ✓ Please limit to 1 adult accompanying children
